The Parish Council have no objections to the conversion but feel that the units should be tied to the farm in perpetuity. <u>133.1.2 Swallow Barn (formerly Rowson House Barn), Church Street:</u> Removal of condition 6 of planning permission NP/DDD/1108/0969 to allow for retention of existing Grey's Artstone tiles, for Mr and Mrs M Wilgose. The Parish Council are in support of removal of condition 6. We feel that residents should not be penalised now for what has been a failure of the Authority to monitor and act accordingly.
