

7	REVIEW OF COUNCIL INVOLVEMENT WITH VILLAGE ORGANISATIONS: Members to look into Council's legal obligations in village events.
8	RENOVATION OF SCHOOL PLAYING FIELD: Cllr Macdonald has liaised with Mike Harris, School Governor. Applications have been made for quarry funding and lottery funding for the work required. The Parish Council would like to be informed of a date when these applications may be considered. Cllr Macdonald will invite Mr Harris to the next meeting.
9	VILLAGE MARKET DAY: The Chairman had received a letter from the secretary of the Market Committee detailing the stalls proposed and which charities each represents.
10	RIGHTS OF WAY MINOR MAINTENANCE SCHEME: Claim to be sent by the end of May. £415 of the £430 allocated to Monyash has been spent maintaining local footpaths.
11	SATURDAY COMMUNITY WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE: Dates for the forthcoming year have been received and advertised on the village notice board. Flyers to be delivered to all residents nearer to the first collection date.
12	LAND ADJACENT TO CHANDLERS: Members further discussed this issue raised by a resident during the Annual Parish meeting. Safety concerns have been raised with regard to work recently commenced. The Clerk was instructed to contact the PDNPA to further investigate this matter.
