119	SALT BIN: The Parish Council feel that an additional salt bin is required in the village preferably in close proximity to the notice board. Due to the fact that the pavements are not cleared, as people tread on the snow in the Winter it becomes impacted down to very hard and slippery ice. This is a considerable hazard to all, especially the elderly and schoolchildren who walk to and from the village hall each day. The Clerk was instructed to enquire whether a new salt bin is possible, to help alleviate the problem.
