The 10% goodwill re-payment they requested has been paid some months before therefore ther Parish Council was expecting to have the grant paid by now. The Clerk Mrs Alison Wales will be instructed to contact the Aggregates Levy and look into this matter.</p>

	<p>Mr Edward Mellor, walling contractor, is to commence work imminently and is hoping for an end of March completion.</p> <p>Mr Jonathan Hutchinson, fencing contractor will complete the fencing work prior to the drainage work commencing.</p> <p>The Clerk Mrs Alison Wales has sent an application for a National Lottery Awards for All Grant and is awaiting a response.</p>
121	<p>VILLAGE TOILETS: The Clerk Mrs Alison Wales has received an email from Robin Walsh at DDDC Community Services to inform the Parish Council that the refurbishment of the village toilets will commence at the end of January. The major works will involve relaying the strip drain in front of the small car park to take the water that runs down the road causing the build up of sludge in front of the toilets. The Parish Council asked for the Clerk Mrs Wales to enquire with regard to cleaning the toilets once the refurbishment is complete.</p>
