34	<p>ORANGE/EE LOCAL MOBILE PHONE MAST: It has been brought to the Parish Council's attention by a resident that the local mobile phone mast for Orange and EE was recently turned off for a period. This resident stated upon complaining to EE he was informed that the Parish Council had been made aware of this action prior to it being implemented. This has most certainly not been the case as neither the Clerk or Members received any notification whatsoever. The Clerk has complained with regard to this to EE and has also received a letter from Patrick McCloughlin who also highlighted this to EE following contact from a group of residents. EE have apologised and the mast has now been re-instated.</p>
