There appears to be 2 main problems:  • Farmers dropping manure during muck spreading and not clearing up after themselves. This has had the effect of covering the road and is unsightly, antisocial and hazardous to traffic, pedestrians and cyclists.  • Traffic driving over roadside verges, especially around the Horse Lane area of the village, this cuts up the verges and has the effect of widening the road, thus increasing the damage.  There was much discussion about this topic and whilst the P.C fully appreciate that the village is at the heart of a farming community, they are keen for all residents to be able to live happily in the village. As such the P.C is committed to strive to find a respectful understanding and solution from all quarters.
