Information on running the toilets, cost etc. has been received and it was agreed to arrange a meeting with the Council. 36	<p>Jack Mere Car park flood prevention Unfortunately, the contact with Breedon quarry is no longer available to us. Due to the dry weather the chatter was not needed before May market, however it is still required to fill in the holes. Action JS</p>
37	<p>Fere Mere Wildlife The wildlife strip of grass has been left unmown as agreed at the last meeting. Meeting with the Environment Agency re. indigenous fish population scheduled for Fri 9th June.</p>
38	<p>Village Hall It is still the Parish Council's view that a committee should oversee the running of the hall, given the perceived upgrading that is required, if its future is to be secured. Following numerous approaches regarding the current and future use of the Village Hall the P.C agreed to formally request (by letter) the Accounts for review. Letter drafted and to be sent. 39	<p>Parking on Church Street Once again, the road has become very dangerous outside Swallow barn due to the number of cars parked outside the property, and residents have approached the P.C. for support in addressing this matter. It was agreed to contact Highways and Cllr Simon Spencer for help in resolving this. Action AJ</p>
40	<p>Neighbourhood watch scheme The Police have approached the P.C to see if we are interested in participating in a NWS. It was agreed that this was of interest and Jo to the action to progress with potential coordinators. Action JS</p>
