43	Mere wall Repair on the wall due to commence in the next couple of weeks. Following discussion with the Peak Park conservation officer S Fowkes it was recommended to keep 3 sides mown and leave one side unmown.
44	Risk Assessment Signage for key risks has been sourced and awaiting delivery. No new risks were identified.
45	Memorial Cleaning The grant application to the war memorial trust has been submitted before the end June deadline and a response should be received within 7 weeks.

46	<p>Jack Mere Car Park and Frost Mere car parking area. Quotes are being gathered to tarmac the Jack Mere car park and the pavement (separate quotes) Sough emptying and drains on Chapel Street The Sough is meant to be emptied 3times /year, but this has not been happening Action LF to chase up with Mark.wooller@derbysheiredales.gov.uk. Although contacted last month no response or action so LF to chase up again. However, the drains have been cleared in June</p>
47	<p>Neighbourhood watch scheme We have been contacted to determine if we are still interested confirmed as yes but no volunteers have come forward to date.</p>
48	<p>Phone Box Painting of box now completed and PC to obtain quotes for tidying up inside and fixing shelves, so it could be used as a repository for books and or local pamphlets of local interest. Action LF to approach district council for possible grant.</p>
49	<p>Public Toilets Initial heads of term have been received from the county council but none of the areas discussed on the phone have been addressed so LF to go back to them to get amended heads of term. Meanwhile to approach council to see if the toilets can be re-opened if Monyash PC agrees to take over managing cleaning of toilets. Councillors will approach local cleaners to see if they would be interested in taking on a contract to clean. In addition, LF to approach Peak Park and natural England for support in keeping toilets open</p>
50	<p>Election of new councillor Following posting of the vacancy S Mudford has formally approached the council and was subsequently confirmed by all councillors. Action LF to contact S Mudford to start at next meeting in September. There is still a potential vacancy for one more councillor so LF to approach those who made initial enquiries to ascertain interest and vacancy notices to remain in place.</p>
