Baslow Rural Crime Public Meeting

Local residents and their representatives have told me of their concerns about rural crime in Baslow and the surrounding area.

This is why I prioritised tackling rural crime in my Police and Crime Plan and have made it clear that I expect to see improvements to the policing service provided to rural areas, such as Baslow.
