48/2023 PRESENT. Councillors, Woolley, Corble, Mudford, Scoggins and White attended the meeting. County Councillor Spencer attended the meeting. District Councillor Elliott attended the meeting. Three members of the public attended the meeting.

49/2023 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE. Resolved to note that there were no apologies for absence.

50/2023 APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES. Resolved that the minutes of the meeting held on the 19th December were a true and correct record. Councillor White signed the minutes.

51/2023 DECLARATIONS OF MEMBER INTEREST. There were no declaration of member interest at this meeting.

52/2023 PUBLIC SPEAKING. County Councillor Spencer gave a report on what can be done and has been done in other villages regarding the speeding issues in Monyash. District Councillor Elliott supported the comments from Councillor Spencer. Councillor Elliott gave information about Derbyshire Dales District Council's more user friendly website. The District Council are also offering grants towards loft insulation but there will be some conditions attached to the grants. The District Council also hold monies for the Hardship Fund and more information is on the District Council's website. The members of the public had attended the meeting regarding the agenda item about the village survey. Comments were also made about the need for more parking spaces in the village.

53/2023 VILLAGE SURVEY. This item is in its infancy but it was included as an agenda item for openness and transparency whilst Chris Woodhouse gave a presentation of the results. Thanks were given to Chris Woodhouse for collating the information. A member of the public has agreed to work with the Parish Council on some of the items identified from the survey.
